The faculty of the UCSF Academic Senate have voted to approve the proposal for the Department of Bioengineering and Therapeutic Sciences. 154 Senate members participated in the vote with 139 (90%) members voting to endorse the proposal, five members (3%) voting against the proposal and ten members (6%) abstaining from the vote.
