Distinction In Faculty Mentoring Awards Nomination Form

The Academic Senate Distinction in Faculty Mentoring Award recognizes exceptional mentoring by faculty to faculty and fellows. (Exceptional mentoring by faculty to students is recognized by the Distinction In Teaching Award.) All faculty in the Ladder Rank, In Residence, Clinical X, Health Sciences Clinical, and Adjunct series with appointments at 50% or more time (at UCSF or its affiliates such as Fresno, the VA or SFGH) are eligible for nomination. This award is given in two categories: faculty at the rank of Associate Professor, and faculty at the rank of Full Professor.

- All submissions must include one (1) original and ten (10) copies. **The copies must be double-sided.**
- Nomination Packets must be submitted to Wilson Hardcastle in the Office of the Academic Senate, Box 0764, or MUE 231, no later than 4:00 P.M. on Thursday, November 19, 2009.

Nomination Packets Must Include the Following

- This Nomination Form
- A Letter of Nomination
- Letters of Support from Protégés: at least three (3) and no more than six (6)

Two letters must be from current protégés. Letters should document the duration of the mentoring relationship, how the mentor has affected the faculty member's career path and trajectory, and offer examples of excellent mentoring.

- Letters of Support from Colleagues: at least one (1) and no more than three (3)

One of these letters may be from the Department Chair, but a letter from the Department Chair is not required.
