Call for Abstracts:

Be part of the historic, first UCSF School of Dentistry Research Day! This special event will be held on March 6, 2003, from 8:15 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. in and around Cole Hall, followed by a reception sponsored by the students' John C. Greene Society. This day is being set aside to celebrate the research accomplishments of students and faculty and help students gain insights into career pathways leading to research.

Plenary sessions will include talks given by invited guest Dr. Kenneth Hargreaves, University of Texas Health Sciences Center, San Antonio; UCSF Chancellor and Nobel Laureate J. Michael Bishop; and the winner of the annual UCSF School of Dentistry Faculty Research Award. We would like as many students and faculty to present oral or poster presentations during the day as possible.

Awards will be presented for the best student/trainee presentations in different categories (i.e., pre-doc, graduate student, post-doc). Students must be the presenter to be award eligible. Faculty and students are encouraged to present abstracts submitted to the ADEA, AADR, IADR or presented at other meetings within the past year. This will be a special opportunity to learn what your colleagues in different oral health science fields have discovered and for everyone to learn what research is in progress.

To submit your abstract for presentation, please complete the attached accompanying information form and submit the text of your abstract on a separate page (see instructions). Please submit both electronically to Mark Jacobs at ResearchDay@DENTISTRY.UCSF.edu by the end of the day on **January 23, 2003**. The list of abstracts selected for presentation will be distributed by *February 6*. We will try to accommodate as many submissions as possible.

RVUs for dental students (more for presenters) and CE credits for faculty will be available. Most clinics will be closed for this day and attendance is expected in lieu of clinic and classes. More details and the full program will follow.

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Instructions for Abstract Submission

Abstracts Due: January 23, 2003

Please enter the following information on the accompanying form:

- Title of your presentation
- One to three keywords
- Preferred method of presentation (oral, poster, or no preference)
- Indicate if you will withdraw your abstract if you do not get your preferred presentation format
- Comments to Review Committee - use this area for special scheduling or sequence requests. For example, if several abstracts are being submitted from the same lab and have an optimal sequence for presentation, please indicate. Please note that while we will make every effort to accommodate your request we can not guarantee that we will be able.
- Name of presenter if different from first author.
- Complete contact information is required for all authors and co-authors: First name, last name, UCSF department, division and box number, or other affiliation and full mailing address, e-mail address, and phone number. Use additional pages as needed.
- Indicate if you are interested in being a session chair or co-chair
- If you are a student, please include your faculty advisor's name and email address, the program enrolled, class year and degree expected (as applicable). If more than one student is an author, add additional sections as needed.

Please submit the text of the abstract on a separate page from the PDF form.

- The abstract should be about 300 words, not more than half a page, using Ariel 12 point font.
- Use IADR format for abstracts.
- First 1-2 lines of text: First and middle initials and last name of all authors in all caps and bold font (**example: J.A. WEINTRAUB**) followed by school and department affiliations (not bolded).
- Start title on a new line using large and small caps in **bold** font.
- The following sections are recommended for the abstract: Objectives, Methods, Results, Conclusions.

- Support - if your study has/had external funding you must also include the source of the funding at the end of the abstract;
- Submit abstract and accompanying information to ResearchDay@DENTISTRY.UCSF.edu by **January 23, 2003**.
