#### Grievances and Disciplinary Actions

Pursuant to Senate Bylaw 336, the Committee commenced the review of a disciplinary case. Upon receiving the charges, a copy of the proposed disciplinary action, and a full statement of the facts underlying the charges were delivered to the accused. The accused was also informed of his/her right to a hearing. When the Committee received no response after three separate requests, they reviewed the merits of the case and determined that the proposed disciplinary sanctions be implemented. The accused has been notified and the matter is now closed.
