The Committee on Academic Personnel appreciated your attendance at their April 18, 2012 meeting to discuss the proposed Open Access Policy at UCSF.

The Committee appreciates the attention the Academic Senate's Committee on Library & Scholarly Communication has paid to this topic since its initial discussion in 2006. It recognizes that other academic institutions including Harvard University have developed and implemented Open Access Publication Policies based on UCSF's intiial research and plan.
