For her outstanding clinical expertise, innovative approach to patient care, and dedication to diversity, equity, and inclusion, Samantha Valle-Oseguera, MD, has been selected as the 2024 recipient of the Clinical Excellence Award for Senior Faculty in the School of Medicine.

Advancing UCSF PRIDE Values

Valle-Oseguera has established herself as a leader in clinical pharmacy through her role at Kaweah Health's Dinuba Rural Health Clinic. She successfully created a clinical pharmacy service in a federally designated Rural Health Clinic that previously had no pharmacist on the team. Her practice is characterized by comprehensive medication management for chronic conditions such as diabetes, hypertension, and cardiovascular disease, with a strong focus on providing care in patients' preferred languages. As one of only two Spanish-speaking ambulatory care pharmacists, she frequently receives compliments from patients who appreciate her bilingual communication and her approachable manner.

Valle-Oseguera is committed to innovation within the clinical realm, implementing improved clinical pathways, streamlining patient care experiences, and undertaking novel quality improvement initiatives. She is instrumental in currently piloting Eng a co-visit model involving both a physician and a pharmacist, which will serve as a model for other clinics within the organization.
