Nominators should submit the following as one PDF document:

- One letter of nomination from the nominator (not to exceed two pages). The letter can include multiple signatures from supporters.
- Nominee's current curriculum vitae.

The letter of support should be a comprehensive summary of the quality and accomplishments of the nominee towards shared governance at UCSF. The letter should focus on the scope and impact of their Senate service efforts and should detail what sets them apart from other faculty, such as philosophy, objectives, or impact.
