UCSF leadership has done an exceptional job raising funds to support our key missions. As the Senate reported in its <u>article</u> on the Diller Gift, this recent historical \$500M gift from the Helen Diller Foundation to UCSF is exceptional in that it is not directed to a specific field of work or group of recipients. Tentative plans would earmark \$200M toward endowments to faculty. The Senate received 370 <u>responses</u> to its February Question of the Month on the Diller gift (see the article for more details), and Academic Planning & Budget Chair Chad Christine led a Task force aimed at drafting recommendations for campus Administration, regarding the priorities for the application of these endowment funds..
