RE: School of Pharmacy ballot proposals

Dear Faculty,

On February 9, 2018, the Faculty in the School of Pharmacy (SOP) approved three (3) proposals to modify its regulations, amend its bylaws, as well as adopt a new, three-year curriculum.

In accordance with <u>bylaw 35F</u>: Modification of Legislation and <u>SFR 775</u>: Grades, a vote of the San Francisco Division (SFD) is required because the proposals, if approved, affect faculty in the School of Medicine.

Therefore, the SFD is required to take action on the following proposals:

- 1. Adoption of the SOP's new, three-year curriculum, in accordance with SFD bylaws <u>7C, 7D</u>, and 35F. Majority approval required.
- 2. Amendments to SOP bylaws VI, VII and VIII, in accordance with SFD bylaw 35 A-F. Two-thirds approval required.
  - Bylaw section VIII (8.2.3 and 8.2.3.1) establishes the Committee on Academic Standards and the Subcommittee on Academic Progress.
  - Bylaw sections VI and VII adopts technical language to the SOP standing committee functions and membership.
- 3. Modification to SFR 775. A modification is required to adopt SOP faculty regulations I, III, IV, and most notably, V: Grades and Credit. Majority approval required.

SFR 775 establishes a letter grade system for UCSF's professional schools. A modification to SFR 775:

- Adopts revisions to section V of the SOP faculty regulations.
- Offers all PharmD curricula on a pass/no pass grading system, beginning with the entering class of 2018.
- · Includes an honors option.
