Dear Senate Chair Greenblatt:

Thank you for requesting feedback from UCSF Senate Standing Committees on the use of the 2017-2018 Senate's Chancellor's Funds.

The Rules & Jurisdiction Committee (RJC) discussed this at its October 2017 meeting and via email and has the below requests for funding. RJC members put forth the following proposal:

In light of the recent fires in and around Northern California, committee members discussed a disconnect experienced by many from their community and the community that UCSF itself serves through direct patient care and through its research.

As such, members are advocating for either a floating Community Service Day to be implemented at UCSF, which will permit faculty to spend time in their designated community for its betterment. They request small funding amounts (\$1000 each) to be provided to defray any costs directly put into the day by faculty.
